Non-Issued Items

- Towels (3) & Washcloths (2)
- Underwear 5 pair (Bras required for females)
- Shower shoes (1 pair)
- Sneakers (2 Pair) However, 1 can be water shoes, but they must have a closed toe and heel)
- Black athletic shorts (2 pair)
- Blanket (1) or sleeping bag and (1) pillow
- Toilet Articles-Enough to last for 4 days, such as toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, razor, shaving cream, etc.
- A pair of black shorts & tennis shoes are needed for field day.
- Female hygiene items.
- Sun Block, insect repellent
- One Piece Swimsuit (1)
- Locking suitcase or padlock for a case/bag you can lock
- Minimum spending money (\$10-20 recommended).
- Hand-held flashlight with batteries
- **Large plastic bags to waterproof inside of duffle bag.**

Military Items (Issued)

- JROTC School PT T-Shirt
- OCPs (2-3 pair) / ACUs accepted if school has no OCPs.
- Tan T-shirts (4 each)
- Boots (1 pair minimum-boots should be broken-in)
- Boot socks (4 pair minimum)
- OCP Cap / ACU Cap accepted if school has no OCPs.
- Tan belt
- Pistol Belt and canteen (2 canteens may be carried - also Camel Packs Authorized)
- Duffle Bag (when available in individual programs)

Prohibited Items

- Jewelry (watches are permitted)
- Teddy bears, dolls etc.
- Stereos, radios, CD players
- No illegal substances, such as alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- If taking a prescription drug, you must notify your Army Instructor.
- No fire related items (matches, lighters). No fires are permitted at camp.
- Walkee talkees

Optional Items:

- Sunglasses
- Camel pack hydration system
- Disposable camera

Security

A locking suitcase/bag will be required to secure your valuables. Army Instructors or Scout officials will not be responsible for any losses or damage to your equipment.

Cell phone-iPod Policy: Cellular phones and other electronic devices ARE NOT allowed at JCLC in accordance with Cadet Command policy. It is highly recommended that cadets leave these devices at home. If they are brought from home, they must be collected by cadre prior to arriving at Camp Panther Hillsborough on the bus on Day 1. There is a camp phone manned 24/7 and cadre should provide phone tree roster with contact phone numbers to parents/guardians prior to camp. Additionally, cadre are encouraged to give parents their personal cell number for emergency purposes only.
